Milton Keynes has more than 177 miles of dedicated cycle paths called "Redways" which are designed to go above and below roads so cyclists can avoid crossing busy highways.

There are plenty of fun routes including Heritage Cycle trails, National Cycle Route 6 and 51, the Grand Union Canal and the Millennium Cycle Route, as well as routes past lakes, and through woods and parks. You can even plan your own route using one of the council's Redway Maps. Details can be downloaded from www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/cyclemk
