Award-winning Shona Shah has been dancing Bollywood-style since she was six years old in 2003 when her parents took her to a workshop held in the City Church, Milton Keynes



Shona has performed in London, Milton Keynes, Leicester and Wales – for various celebrations, and for city heritage and charity events. Her first performance was at the Diwali Show 2004. Star performances since include Milton Keynes Volunteer Awards 2007 at the Hockey Stadium; and two days of music and dance in July 2008 for It's in the Square. At Milton Keynes' 40th anniversary in 2007, Shona was the youngest solo performer, selected to represent Milton Keynes' Hindu Community, performing Aashiqui Meri (My Love) at Milton Keynes Theatre.
