A campaign built up rapidly in the 1970s, they called it "Milton Keynes Is Dying for a Hospital". Their actions led to the creation of a four-ward community hospital that was built in 1979, 5 years before the construction of the main hospital. The silver anniversary of the hospital was celebrated 3

years ago; it has now been serving and treating people for 28 years.

Milton Keynes Hospital provides a comprehensive range of services to the local population. The vast majority of visits come from the immediate area of Milton Keynes. The hospital has come a long way in a short amount of time. The hospital has a statue outside the main entrance.
