Local lamb and beef

Milton Keynes' very own Parkland Produce

Local residents and businesses can now enjoy door-to-door delivery of the city's own free-range, high quality lamb and beef from animals reared on Milton Keynes' parkland.

Parkland Produce, a new Parks Trust venture, provides grass-reared meat with all profits re-invested into the Trust's care for our green spaces.

Grazing cows and sheep can reach parts of the parks that mowers can't – on around 700 acres of land, including the Ouse and Ousel Valley, Shenley Toot, Woughton-on-the-Green and Campbell Park.

Their nibbling helps to promote wildflower growth!

To ensure that the meat is tender and of the highest quality the lamb and beef is hung and butchered locally and then delivered in insulated, recyclable boxes.

This year the Trust is hoping to develop more parkland products, including honey and firewood.
