Holy Trinity Church, Old Wolverton
There has been a place of worship on the
site of the Holy Trinity Church at Old
Wolverton for nearly 1000 years. The
medieval church was rebuilt in 1809 -1815
with stone from Warwickshire and
Staffordshire conveyed to the site by the
new canal network. With its 17th
limestone paving, medieval stone spiral
staircase, stencilled wall paintings and
stained glass window, the church is listed
Grade 2\*.
