The Old Bradwell Beer and Bun Race

A glass of beer and a hot-cross bun!

Founded c1965 by three village natives – Messrs Smith, Johnson and Chapman – the Old Bradwell Beer and Bun Race is run on Good Friday from the Victoria Inn.

Contestants must run round the village with a glass of beer in one hand and a bun in the other, the winner being whoever arrives back at the pub with the most beer left in the glass.

Runners are disqualified if they go over the time limit (7 minutes for men, 9 minutes for women); or if they carry the bun in their mouths with a hand over the beer; or if friends top up the beer before they reach the finishing line!
