## thehub:mk



Officially opened by HM The Queen and HRH The Duke of Edinburgh in Nov 2007 thehub:mk is designed to be a focal point for all who live, work, meet, dine and shop in Central Milton Keynes. With its cosmopolitan Central Piazza and spectacular water features this thriving location boasts pavement cafes, shops, bars, restaurants, apartments and two hotels.

A Combined Heat and Power System (CHP) supplies electricity and heat to thehub:mk (hotels, apartments and offices) and Sainsbury's development as well as the proposed new residential area in the West End of the city centre. CHP is the means by which the heat produced during the generation of electricity can be put to good use, rather than being wasted. In addition CHP uses this generated heat to produce hot water for heating buildings in a surrounding area by a district heating system.
