

# Helmut Jacoby

1926 – 2005



Helmut Jacoby was born in Halle, Germany in 1926.

He trained to be an architect in Berlin and Stuttgart, and then went to the Graduate School of Design at Harvard in the United States. Here he specialised in graphics. He was part of the post-war generation that harnessed new technologies for the rebuilding programmes after the War.

Between 1958 and 1968, Jacoby worked with many distinguished American architects, and his drawings were often the first sight that Europe had of the new buildings in America.

In 1968, Helmut decided to return to Europe and set up his studio in Wiesbaden.
