The Cowper and Newton Museum

This exhibition links aspects of Communication that are central to exhibitions in two museums in Milton Keynes – Bletchley Park and Milton Keynes Museum.

They are joined by 3 other organisations spearheading plans for the development of heritage in Milton Keynes:

- City Discovery Centre including a library and archive of the New City;
- Living Archive with a role recording oral history;
- Cowper and Newton Museum focussing on the writers of the Olney Hymns.
