Hall of Transport



The Museum's Hall of Transport contains items associated with roads, railways and canals to explain why the area's position has made it a 'crossroads' through the ages. It is one of the newest buildings on the site, built specifically to house the Museum's large collection of transport items.

Tram

A special attraction in the collection The Wolverton and Stony Stratford Tram ran between the two towns in northern Buckinghamshire from the 1880s to the 1920s. It was the last steam tram way to operate in the whole of Britain, and one of the few ever to run over rural routes.
