1. Oldbrook's main landmark, the Cricketers pub, run by Greene King, overlooks The Green. It was opened in 1983 by cricketer Mike Selvey who was capped three times for England. The Cricketers pub is a community meeting place. They sometimes have fun days.
2. All of the street names in Oldbrook are named after famous cricketers like Sutcliffe, Hutton, Appleyard, Boycott, Evens and Dexter.
3. The Oval is a famous cricket ground. There is a street named after the Oval in Oldbrook.

6. There are a few shops including Tesco, Lidl, Dominos Pizza, Sally's hairdressers, a Chinese takeaway, Blockbuster video and two corner shops.
