Queens Court



Queens Court is an integral part of thecentre:mk building. It was one of the main features of the building in 1979 and remains key to the success of thecentre:mk into the future. In the past 30 years Queens Court has hosted a variety of events including German Markets, Ice Rinks, and the screening of world cup games.

Queens Court is currently going through a redevelopment to ensure it remains a dynamic space in the fabric of Milton Keynes. Four restaurant units will be built on the east and west sides of Queens Court, with under-cover seating in a winter garden style colonnade overlooking the revitalised central courtyard.



The colonnade will have fully retractable glass doors, enabling customers to sit outside when the weather is good.

The new Queens Court has been carefully designed to create a public space with its own distinct identity. It will encourage free movement across the courtyard and enliven and animate the space with activity all year around in the central events space. The aim is also to provide contrasting yet complementary 'zones' for visitors with the raised reflection pool to the north and a more relaxing area, with seating beneath the trees at the southern end.
