Although activities are open to all, Inter-Action MK has also provided a focus for groups of people with disabilities- always working in partnership from start to finish.

International Day of Disabled People was marked with various activities, usually leading to a performance such as the very popular Can Can Cabaret, which involved both local and national disabled performers.

Inter-Action MK played a big part in Milton Keynes' Disability Arts Strategy that was formulated during the 1990s.

A long and successful partnership with Bucks Association for the Blind (now Bucks Vision) produced exhibitions, a giant chess set and sculptures for The Old Rectory garden.

In 2010, Groovy Gecko, a fantastic club night organised by a crew of learning disabled adults continued to provide a great night out for people in Milton Keynes and beyond.
