The founder, Mrs. Soskin, bought the Newport Pagnell site in 1970 which became Bury Lawn Primary School. In 1977 she bought the Knoll School in Aspley Heath which became the secondary school. Now the school is all under one roof in Stantonbury Fields – you will notice that Soskin Drive is named after Mrs. Soskin.

The current school building, Bury Lawn was purpose built in 1986 and opened in 1987. Before this time the school had been in two separate buildings in two different locations.

In 2003, the private company Global Education Management Services (GEMS) from Dubai bought the school. A year later, a new sports hall was built, a new music room, a dance/drama studio, an ICT suite and a maths department were added to the main building. In 2006, the science department was completely refurbished and four new labs were opened.
