Bernard Schottlander, 1924 – 1999

The Milton Keynes Sculptures

In 1972 Schottlander exhibited at Park Royal where the Milton Keynes Development Corporation chose four of his most avante garde pieces and placed them like monumental markers in the landscape designated for the New City. His clean geometric style, influenced by the Bauhaus, was perfectly in tune with the early architecture of Milton Keynes.

The four sculptures were originally sited at Wavendon Tower, the HQ of Milton Keynes Development Corporation. The first three were then moved in 1983 to the Public Gardens, behind the City Church, and MS Series no.1 was moved to Challenge House, Sherwood Drive, Bletchley.

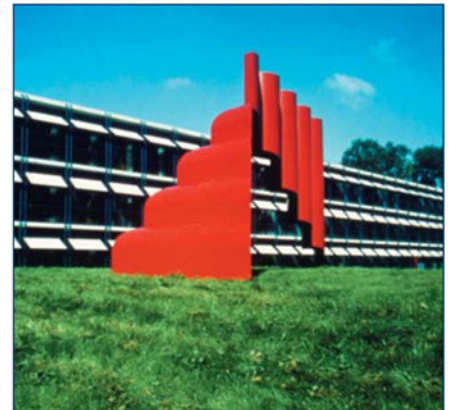
2M Series No.4
